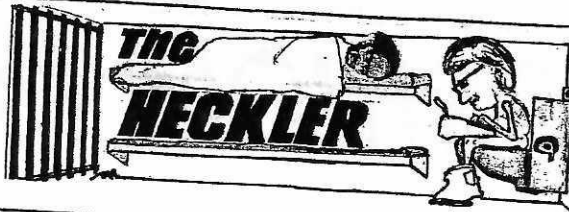

# SHAKEDOWN SHAKES UP OFFICERS

## BURGLARIES BAFFLE POLICE

A strange string of burglaries of at least ten homes in the Rosharon area have victims baffled and police searching for the culprits and motive behind the ransackings.

At a news conference Tuesday, Brazoria County Sheriff Charles Wagner presented details of the bizarre break-ins. "The modus operandi was similar at all locations. All the victim's belongings were sorted and either placed in a small plywood box, thrown in the trash, or stolen." Wagner also indicated that the "stolen" items had been listed in detail on a confiscation form left at the scene, and described the crime spree as "the most bizarre event in Brazoria County's history."

This latest rash of burglaries is actually similar to a smaller series of burglaries which took place six months earlier, all of the victims being employees of TDCJ.

Officer Williams of the infamous Darrington Unit was hit hard. "They wiped out my pantry and most of my clothes," said Williams as she read the long list of confiscated items. "Oh my God, they took my Count Chocula cereal and three of my four baseball hats!"

Officer Ford's losses varied from Williams. "All my appliances are gone—phones, TV's, typewriter, lamps, everything but this worthless two foot long, two-plug multioutlet."

"They got all my appliances, too," says officer Jordan. The confiscation papers said 'no property receipts', but that's not fair! Things were tight and I found a good estate sale and they don't give receipts."



"What did we do to deserve this!" say officers

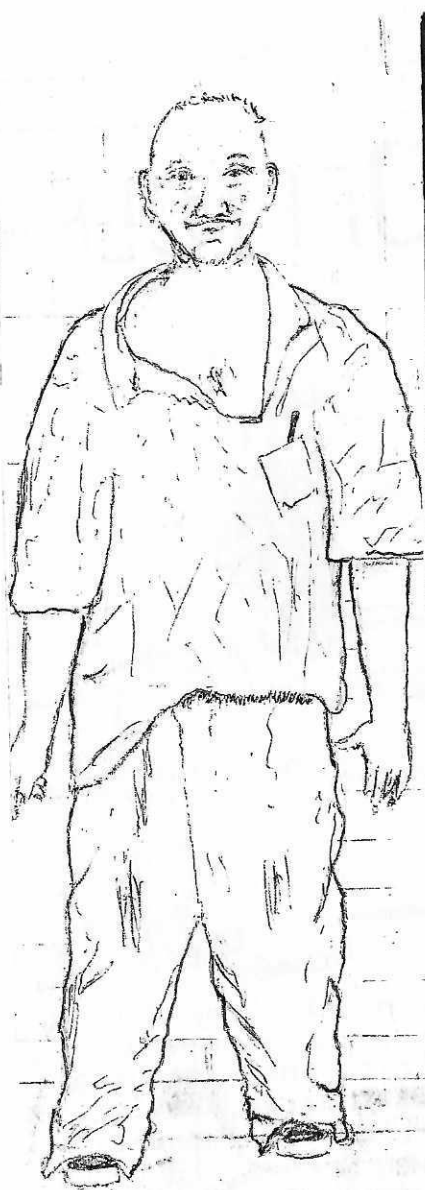
Police have narrowed possible suspects into two groups. First, that the perps are recently paroled inmates seeking retribution for similar treatment during incarceration. Second, that the burglaries are the work of present or former TDCJ guards who have developed an addiction to such activities.

"Some people just get a thrill out of invading someone's personal belongings, taking things at will, knowing the victim can do little or nothing about it."

The victims are pointing fingers at paroled inmates, but police forensic psychologists consider that theory remote at best. "The perps are obviously experienced at this type of activity. Besides, I can't see an inmate getting much of a thrill deciding which boxers Williams keeps and which get trashed. This is definitely rogue officers power tripping again."



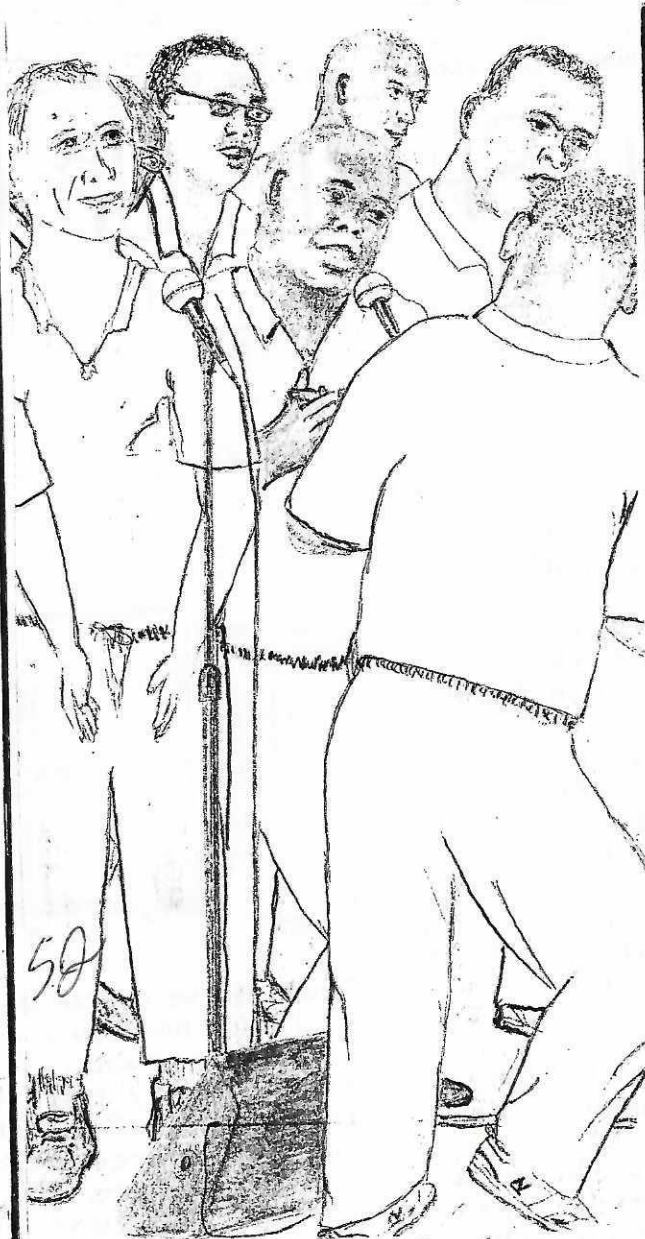

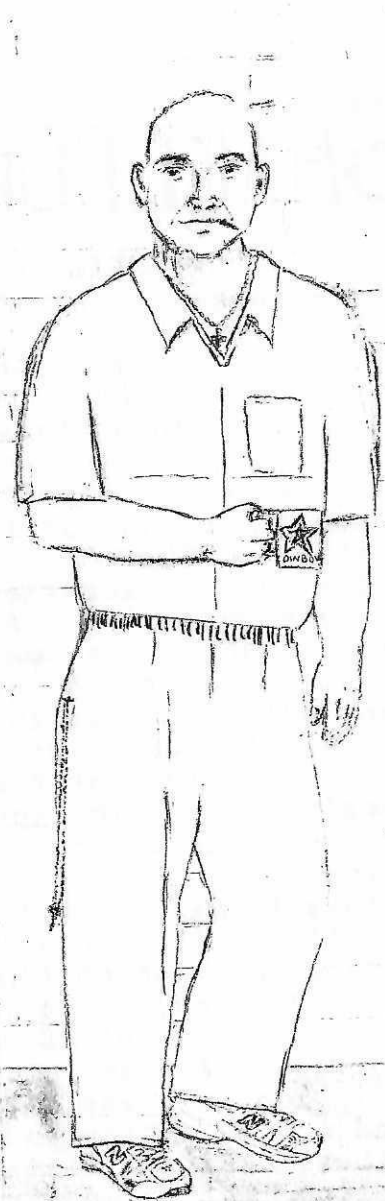


## CHURCH WEAR

## FORMAL WEAR

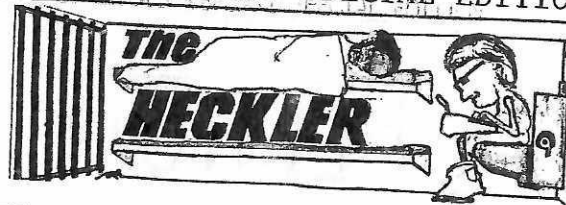
The clear choice for the ultimate player with a good lock and black bags to spare, these starch whites are always in style.

# K-2 SWEEPS TDCJ

## PROPONENTS TOUT HEALTH BENEFITS

Popourri isn't just for glass bowls at granny's house anymore, as inmates across TDCJ have found K-2 to provide numerous mental and physical benefits to enhance the prison experience.

The switch from marijuana usage to K-2 has an economic basis according to CO Onuwakunapi of POLICIA (Prison Officers Letting In Contaband Assn.) "Margins on weed are just too tight, as wholesale prices and transportation costs have skyrocketed. But K-2 is cheap, and makes us smell real good."

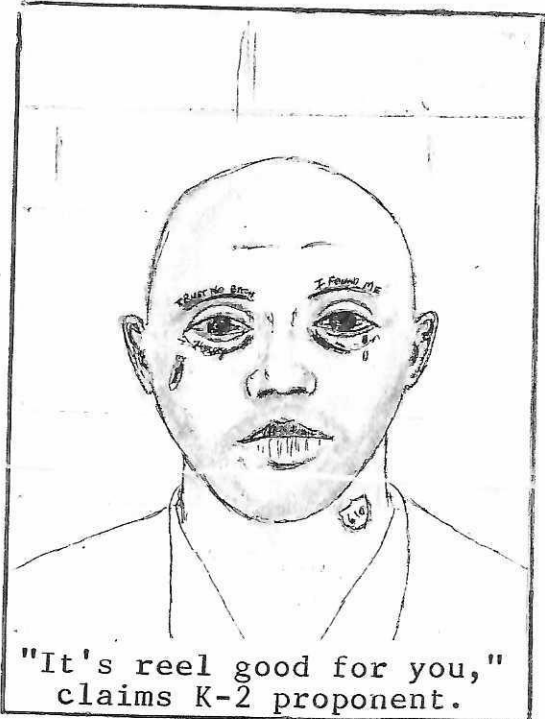
In response to the accusation that labeling on K-2 says 'Not For Human Consumption,' Onuwakunapi defended the union's action. "We're not selling it to humans, just inmates."

Proponents of K-2 dismiss the dire warnings from health officials concerning the dangers of smoking K-2, citing several benefits. "I couldn't get Dr. Hulipas to do anything about my health problems. But within an hour of smoking K-2, I was in the hospital surrounded by people who care."

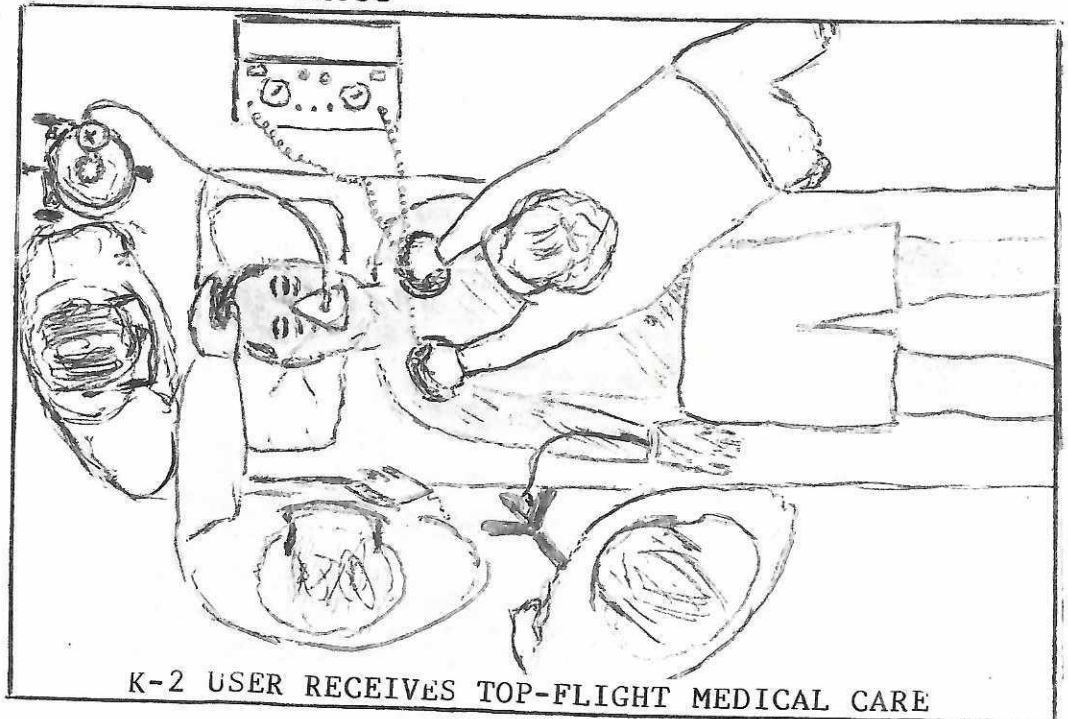
Dr. Hulipas refused a personal interview, but did release the following statement: "Those inmates are all fakers.

I checked their prostate, and there is absolutely nothing wrong with them."

Proponents also claim K-2 enhances health through "beneficial purging," as violent bouts of vomiting are common. And in response to scientists' warning that the 'high' from K-2 is akin to sniffing glue, advocates counter that they only use 10% of the brain anyway. Losing a million or two cells for an hour of delirium is a good trade, as watching ESPN isn't too hard to do.

# Clothing/CHEMICAL CARTEL BUSTED



The infamous "P-3 Cartel" was dealt a potentially fatal blow last week, as the tireless efforts of Darrington's Cpt. Bellamy led to the discovery of a record-setting stash of bleach, detergent, and new inmate clothing. Bellamy downplays her role, thanking the 72 snitches that revealed the cache and identified the alleged kingpins, Juju and Smiley, known for their brutal tactics.

The cache was ingeniously hidden in the chemical/clothing storage room, and included substantial funds. Seized

under the RICO Act, guards recovered 6322 stamps, 251 black bags, 563 mackereels, and a yet undetermined number of mintsticks. Street value of the clothing is an estimated 7500 stamps, and value of the bleach at a whopping 20,000 stamps, though investigators await test results determining whether the bleach was pure, or cut with Degest.

Cpt. Bellamy was reportedly elated with the find and said to have "danced a jig" upon discovery. "I wondered why the clothes came out so filthy and grey. Now they won't be grey anymore!"

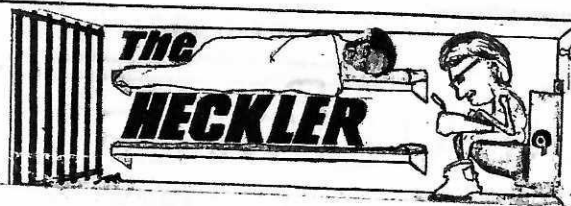

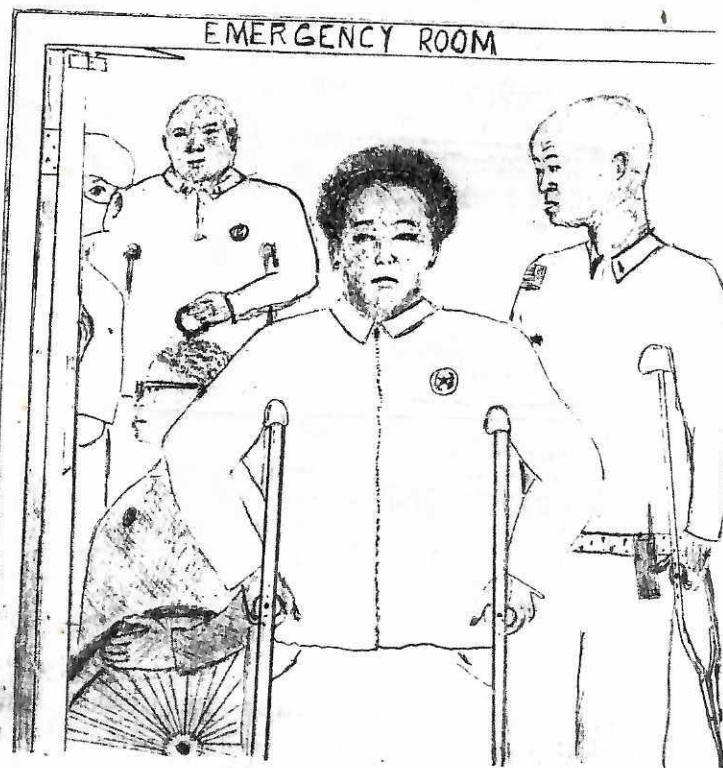
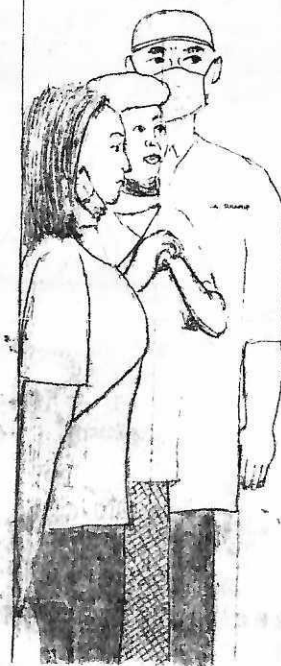

# YELLOW LINES ELECTRIFIED DOZENS HOSPITALIZED

Prison administrators desperate to curb inmate disobedience secretly electrified the yellow lines. Unaware that inmate shoes are non-conductive, shockingly resulting in 22 guards lying unconscious in the hallway.

The injured were taken to the nearest emergency room where medical personnel were unprepared for the ensuing chaos triggered by the presence of seasoned TDCJ officers. "We heard the screaming the moment they arrived," says one ER nurse, "screams of 'GET OFF THE NOISE' and 'FACE THE WALL' and 'ONE WAY TRAFFIC!'".

The hospital continues to try and recover from the event—cleaning up from 3 pepper spray incidents, and renewed efforts to locate 2 doctors, locked up by a large TDCJ captain for asking him a question.



## "Lockdown Big Success" SAY PROPERTY ROOM OFFICERS

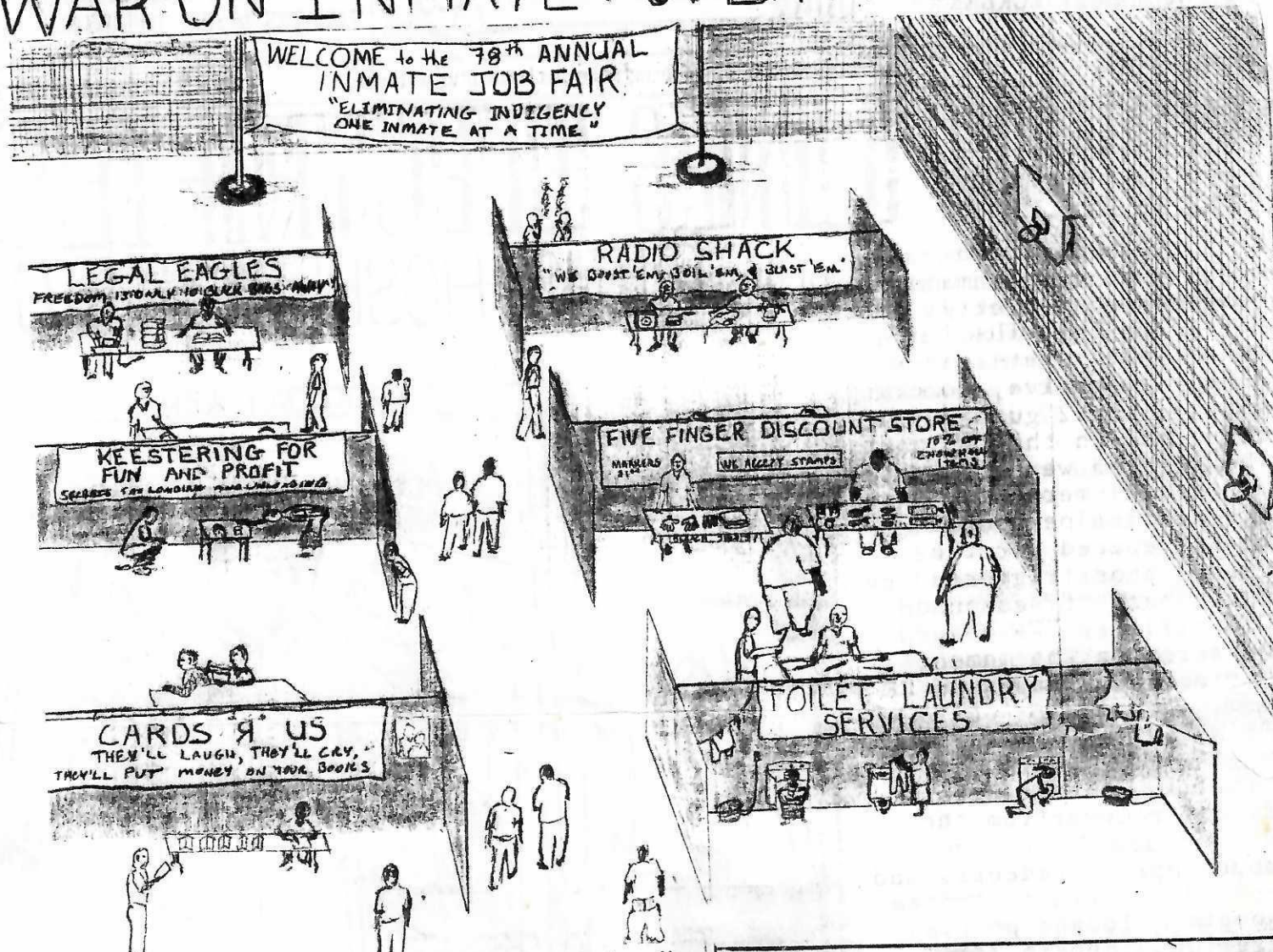
Fears concerning budget shortfalls for 2015 eased as results from this year's bi-annual shakedown showed a 40% gain in revenue compared to 2013.

Stung in recent years by the loss of revenue from the resale back to inmates of confiscated cell phones, TDCJ has struggled to make ends meet. But brilliant efforts on the part of property officers, such as Ms. Ford of Darrington Unit, tapped into an under-utilized revenue source. "It's a seller's market for typewriters and fans out there, but the real thanks goes to inmates and their fake papers."

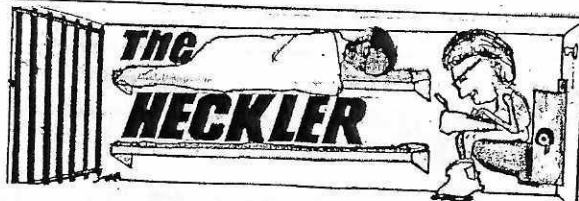

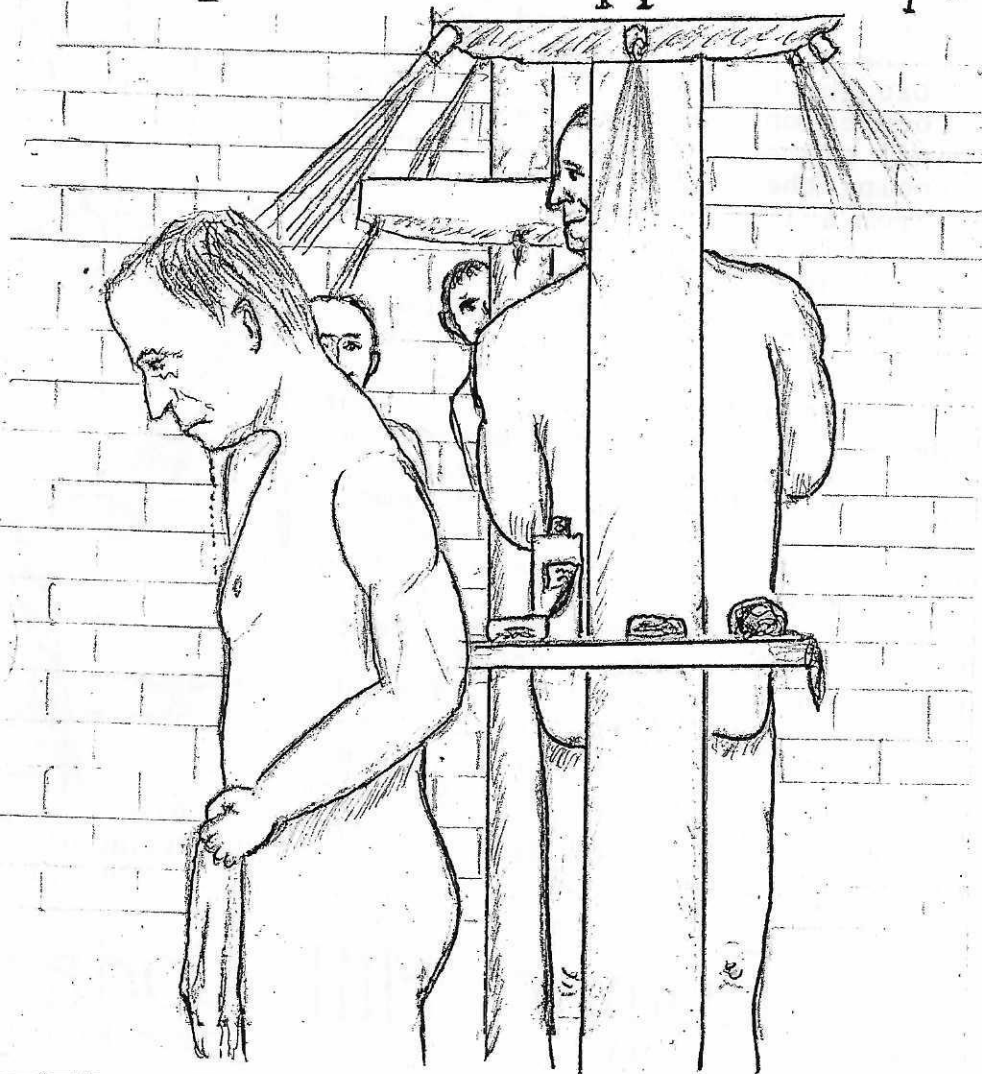

# "It's Safe To Pick Up Your Dropped Soap," says PREA.

Texas prison officials confirmed reports that Darrington's group showers are now clear of potential dangers and that "offenders no longer need to hesitate to pick up soap or other dropped items while showering." The announcement marked a radical change in the unit power's past reputation as the Deliverance Room," referring to some obscure movie scene. Old school inmates, like the seasoned O'Neal, are not so convinced. "I'm leaving mine on the floor," says the former trusty. And Laird, what's up with that soap-on-a-rope you said you'd ordered?"

Certain precautions still apply, as well as basic shower etiquette: look four ways before bending; kick the soap at least 4' from the nearest offender; do not stare at other offenders as they bend to retrieve soap; avoid unwanted attention by bending at the knees, not the waist.



## Pope Cancels Visit To Darrington

In response, a spokesperson for the unit issued the statement, "K-2 is getting into the unit somehow, and we cannot rule out Francis at this time."

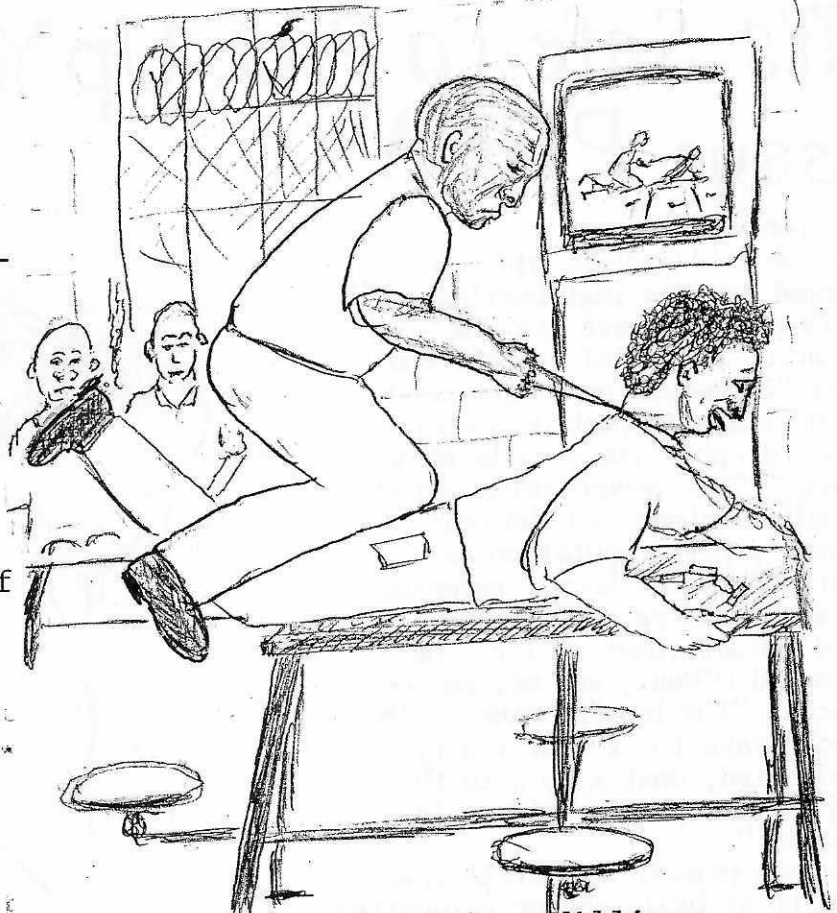


# Bible College Students Begin Near-Death Experience Ministry

Darrington inmates can now see the light at the end of the tunnel with a bold new ministry designed to expose offenders to the ultimate spiritual experience—death. Inspired by numerous tales of people having died and then brought back to life, the ministry focuses on Darrington's hardened criminal element in the hope that "experiencing the light" will spur men away from a life of crime and into a relationship with God, and maybe a book deal or two along the way.

Though new rules require all participants to first volunteer for the program, one unsuspecting inmate was caught off-guard by a zealous student who proceeded to choke the man out as a demonstration to K-Line's dayroom of the program's effectiveness. Attempts to reach the first subject at John Sealy Hospital were fruitless, and to date, the man is not scheduled to testify at any upcoming church events.

Those offenders interested in participating in the program should send an I-60 to the chaplain's office requesting the "See The Light" program. Due to limited manpower, no-neck offenders (ie. Big Ball, Big Body) will not be allowed, and offenders must supply their own choke cord.

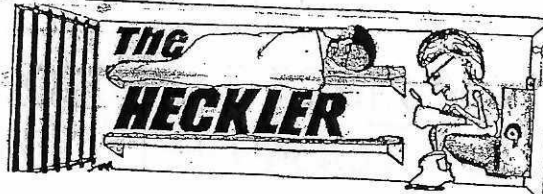
#### KEYS TO CRAFTING A GREAT RUMOR

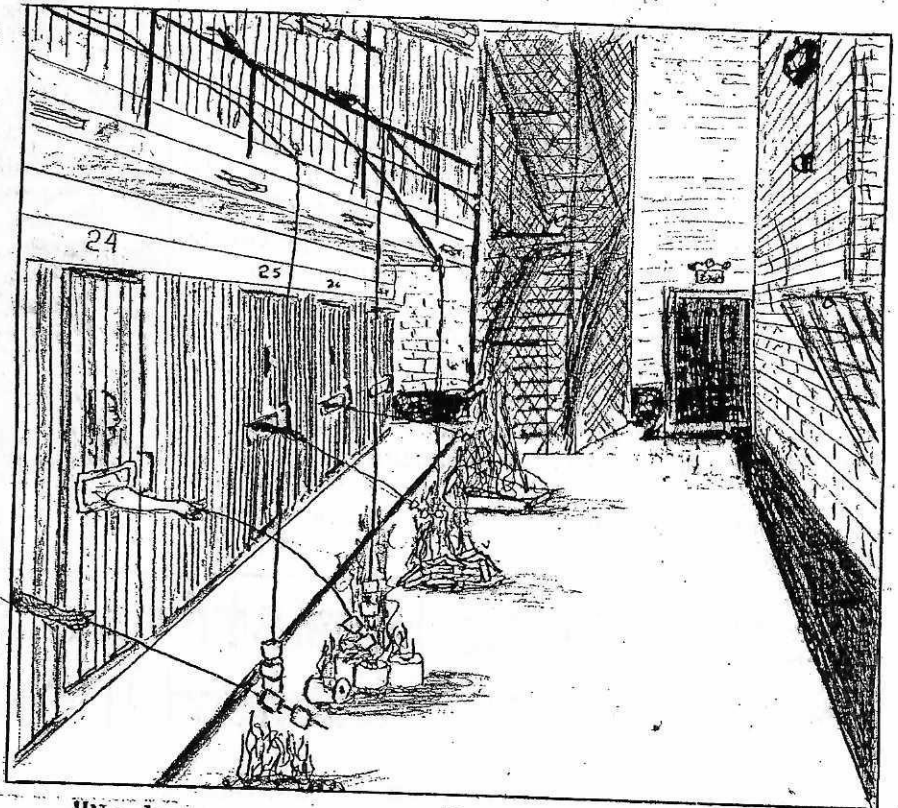

# SEG INMATES DEMAND MORE REC, MARSHMALLOWS

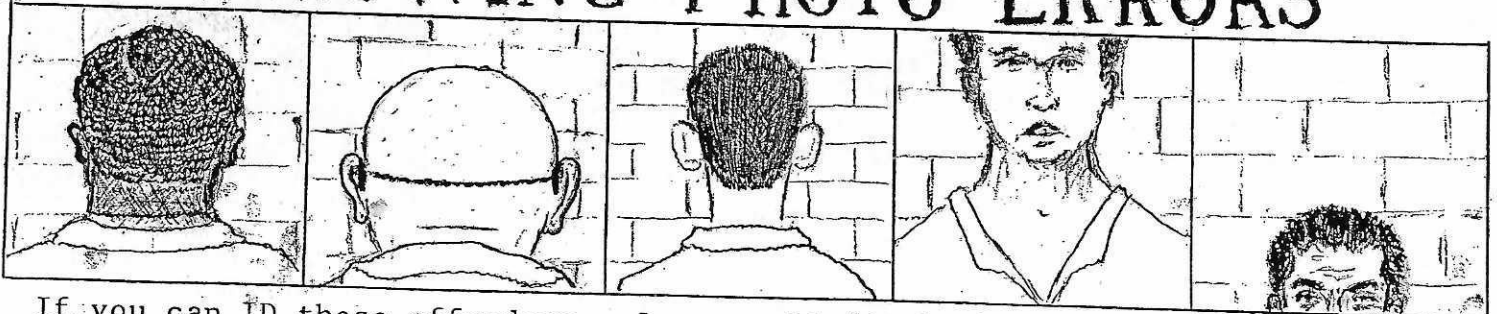
Controversial segregation practices of TDCJ are under new pressure from inmates, leaving officials baffled at the apparent dissatisfaction of seg offenders with cell conditions, lack of recreation, and prison life in general. "It appears these men have trouble adjusting to the isolation, but give them a few more years and they'll become productive members of prison society," says TDCJ Director Stephens.

Seg spokesperson Keith Cook disagrees. "All we want is to be able to see the sun once a week, and maybe play some basketball once a month." When asked about the fires and other demands, Cook stated, "A lot of us missed out on Boy Scouts, and we feel marshmallows and some extra toilet paper for clean burning fires is not too much to ask for; not those little ones, the big marshmallows."

# DENTIST PROMOTES BOXING LESSONS TO COMBAT TOOTH-LOSS IN PRISON

## "Keep your left up," says Broussard

Tooth loss in prison continues to plague inmates, and Darrington's own Dr. Broussard, DDS, intends to put a stop to it. "It's not candy or poor flossing that's ruining these men's smiles, it's a mean right jab and a kick to the teeth," says the popular dentist. Citing poor defensive techniques as the cause, he has set up a training facility in the unused portion of his office where a select group of chronic losers are coached in the art of deflecting punches.

"Keep your left up!" screams Broussard to the appreciative offenders. "This gives us hope," agree The Heckler and sparing partner Lurch. After losing ten teeth in as many years in prison, The Heckler expressed, "When Lance served corn-on-the-cob, I would break down in tears, and I knew pork chops would be impossible to eat before long, until Doc picked me to thain."

# Street Name Registration Now Required - Record # of 5th Ward Inmates Prompts Rule

Inmate Counsel representatives met Thursday, approving new requirements and rules for 'street names' used by offenders on Darrington. The move is in response to continued confusion where multiple inmates use the same street names, as happened recently: Two black bags sent from the tanks to '5th' were lost in the shuffle between the dozen or so '5th's' on P-3, followed by the confusion when a parley ticket signed 'Money' hit 1st place on the Super Bowl, and four inmates claimed the ticket was theirs.

To prevent further conflicts, certain common street names must now be registered for use. In addition, inmates can no longer use the names 'Money', 'G Money, or

any money name unless he actually has money.

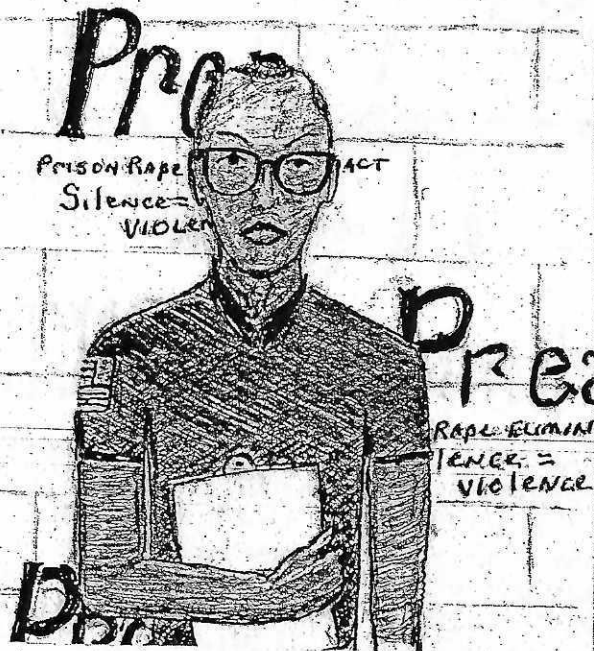

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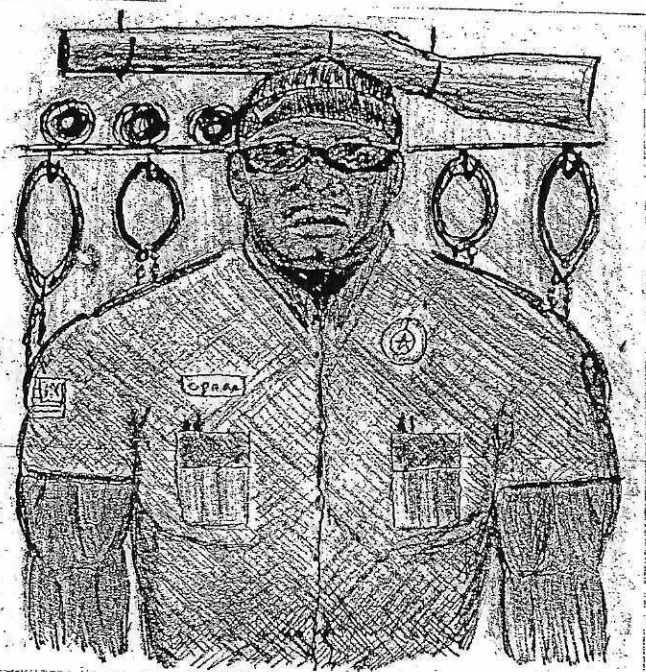

# GUARD PRESIDENTIAL RACE HEATS UP Which MESSAGE WILL APPEAL TO VOTERS?

The culture wars spilled over into Texas prisons, where election of president reflects two completely different mindsets on how to best treat the 155,000-man inmate population. Progressive Party candidate Hagan presents a platform of ideas based on the novel theory that "treating an inmate like an animal does not necessarily produce men that adapt well in society." He promises to put an end to long-term segregation, to replace C-F gas with ammonia, and to replace Darrington's Classification Department with the more reliable Texas Lotto system.

The Regressive Party Candidate, CO Opara, represents what some consider the far right wing of the prison guard electorate, a segment of the guard population believed to have lost influence in the last decade in response to the prison reform movement.

Sponsored by the TEA Party (Texas East Africans), CO Opara vaulted to the nomination despite his sometimes bizarre platform and comments. "I'm going to build higher fences to keep them from ever leaving, and I'm going to make the residents of 5th Ward pay to have it built!"



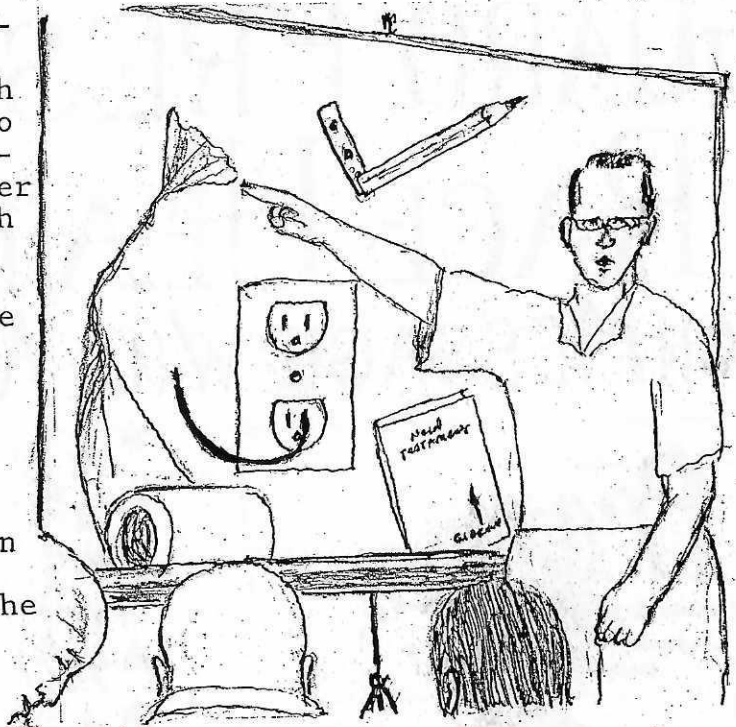
# CRACKHEAD EDUCATION BEGINS

*"BLOW YOUR MIND, NOT THE POWER," this year's theme*

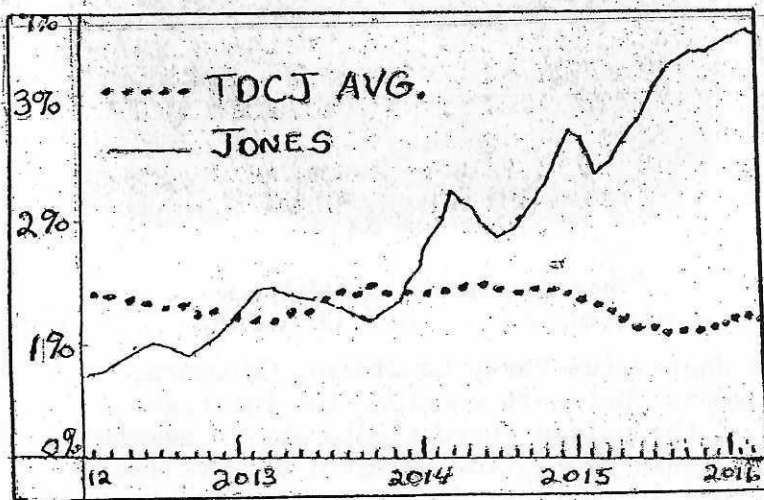
Darrington again leads the way in providing cutting-edge educational opportunities for its inmate population with the new "Crackhead Series." Designed to reach out to those unfortunate individuals who have lost their senses or never had any, the training series deals with practical matters related to prison life.

This Summer's class comes just in time for the scorching Texas summers. Power outages resulting from improper "socket popping" endanger the population as a whole, as the picket bosses continue to find the breaker boxes confusing.

Inmates are encouraged to sign up neighbors for the class which begins in July, God willing and the creek don't rise. Two unnamed smokers will teach the class, with bible college student/teacher Terry Solley available should the teachers get stuck.



## WARDEN JONES' APPROVAL RATING HIGHEST IN TDCJ



Following a tough act of Darrington's first female head warden (Brenda Chaney), Warden Jones knew he had his work cut out for him. But through diligence and hard work, he has earned the respect and admiration of a higher percentage of the inmate population than any other

warden in TDCJ, according to a recent phone survey of TDCJ offenders by The Heckler. A variety of reasons were cited for the glowing reviews. "Man that weather was nice during that last lockdown," said one inmate. "I like the chic-casual look of his outfits and that high-polished dome," said another. "Damn that fried chicken is good. At Estelle we only got casseroles," was a common theme.

In a rare sighting of Jones outside of the ODR or craftshop, the Heckler sought to question Jones about the report as he manned the searcher's desk, but asked for some non-aspirin instead, and a couple of I-60's. "What a great guy," says the Heckler. "He gave me an I-60!" Others attribute the rise in popularity to rumors of flat-screen TV's on the way and conjugal visits (with warden approval).

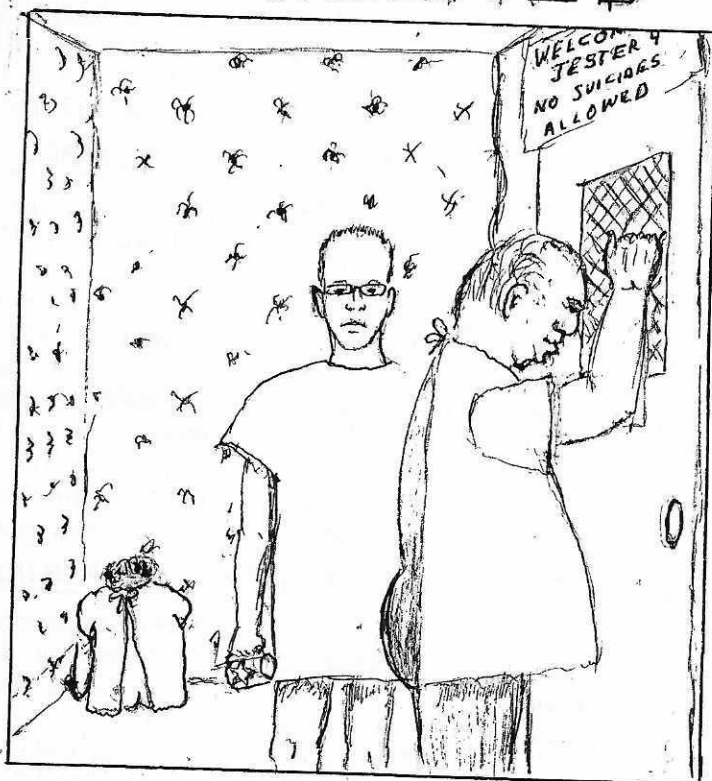
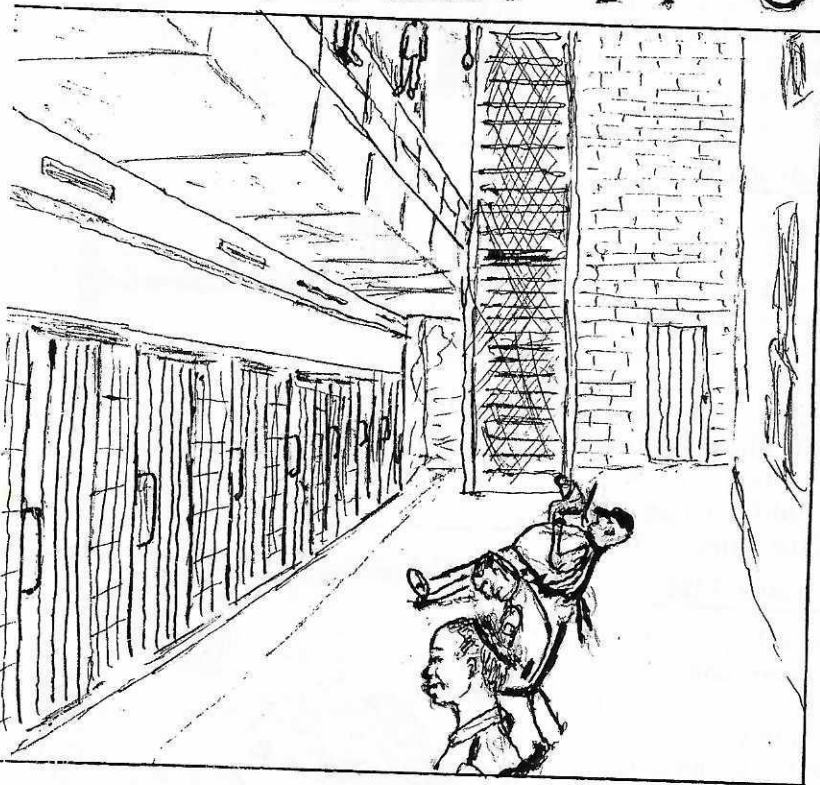

# DALLAS FANS ON SUICIDE WATCH JESTER IV OVERWHELMED



Inmates across TDCJ watched in horror as Green Bay's last-minute field goal dashed Cowboy fans' hope for a Super Bowl berth in 2017. A rare silence descended on dayrooms statewide, followed by soft sobs. The inmates then quietly returned to their cells to pack the commissary they bet on the game, and spend some quiet time trying to make sense of their lives.

By morning, medical was flooded with suicidal inmates who were quickly dressed in those cute blue-paper gowns and placed on suicide watch. By mid-week, psychiatric units Jester IV and Skyview were overwhelmed with the despondent fans.

To alleviate the crisis, MHMR provided TDCJ personnel with helpful grief

counseling tips. If you or your homeboy are struggling with the loss, MHMR offers the following suggestions:

- Redirect negative thoughts and depression into more wholesome and focussed anger toward others, such as:
  - "Those ho-ass refs robbed us."
  - "I hate those cheeseheads!"
  - "Come on, Jerry! Trade Romo for receivers!"
  - "Garrett, you idiot! Why'd you stop running Elliott!"
- Try some positives thoughts as well:
  - "13 & 3 with rookies aint bad."
  - "At least we had a close game, Houston."
  - "Just wait until 1996, 1997, 1998, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018!"

## 3 tips for a Great Day!!

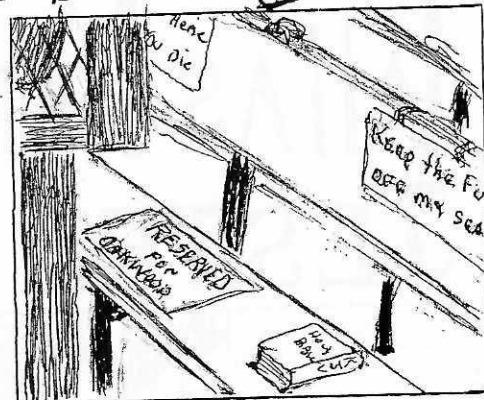
### TIP #1 RESERVE THE PERFECT GAME DAY SEAT

Planning ahead is key to securing the best game-day seating. If you failed to show interest throughout the season by yelling each time the Cowboys ran 3 yards, or by betting it all on pickems and boards, then you face an uphill battle for a seat close enough to catch that wardrobe malfunction.

For those inmates who failed

to make adequate preparations, here are some pointers:

-mark your seat with a threatening note--maybe they don't know you; Avoid using a Bible. They are not effective deterrents in prison dayrooms; or, -bring large quantities of food and snacks, then announce that you need a seat and help with eating all the food.



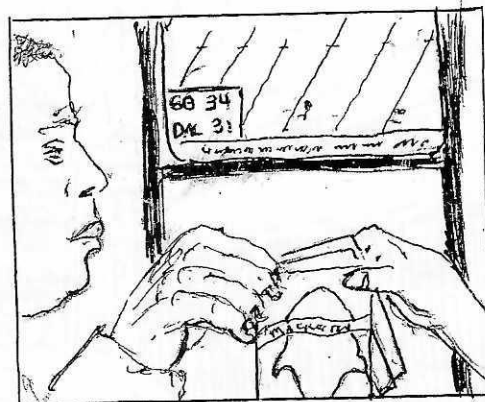
### TIP #2 SAVE ON GAMBLING LOSSES WITH JACKMACKS AND RICE

For those of you not familiar with prison gambling, you can avoid paying full price for your board squares and tickets on any of the 20 parleys on the unit.

The rule of thumb is that any commissary item with a store value of 80-85¢ has a gambling value of a buck. So on a \$5.00 square you can drop 5 jackmacks and beat the man out of 75¢.

[special note to parolees: DO NOT attempt this in Vegas. As a general rule, casinos do not accept mackerels as payment].

Avoid betting with hygiene, as gamblers assign only ½ value to soap, deodorant, and toothpaste. It is not that these items are not valued, rather that we prefer you to use these items, not gamble them away.



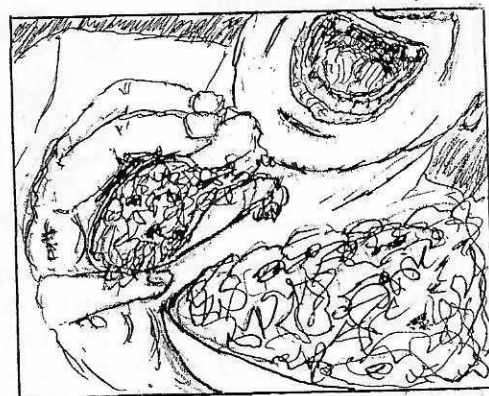
### TIP #3 SAVE \$ ON GAME-DAY SPREADS WITH KITCHEN FOOD ITEMS

Feed your homeboys on TDCJ's time this year with Heckler's Famous 4-Finger Discount Tacos. With 10 stamps, get these items:

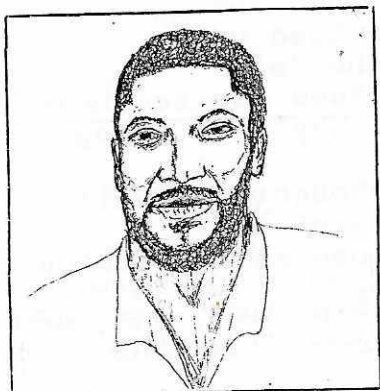
- 2 fresh onions, razor diced;

## EDDIE SPEAKS OUT



"I learned my lesson"

For most inmates, learning that TDCJ personnel always know best takes decades. But for Eddie Marbroué of the Darrington Unit, it only took 12 days solitary confinement to realize that seeking medical help for a dying inmate is a bad move, especially when former witchdoctor, Lt. Amusa, assured

Eddie that offender Thompson was pretending to struggle for breath.

"I'm sorry I called for help," says Eddie. "I guess my faith and trust in TDCJ was weak. They know best when it's an inmate's time to die better than I do. I promise I won't call anybody anymore; I'll let them die. Please, no more seg."
